MONTH OF NEW GROWTH

In 1707, Swedish botanist and naturalist Carl Linnaeus was born. One of his major achievements was the formal introduction of a system of classifying and naming organisms according to genus and species, called binomial nomenclature. The method uses Latin words (a language commonly used by scholars in his day). Several species may exist within one genus, but each species only has one scientific name. Scientists today use a modified version of Linnaeus's system. Because the same naming convention is used throughout the world, it eliminates much confusion when discussing organisms.

So when you are seeing about all the flowers and plants that start growing in May, this is how each one came to have a unique name.
